○ For those who wish to have confirmation prior to vaccination with the "COVID-19 vaccine" at our hospital

It has been recognized that the COVID-19 infection tends to be worse in people with lowered physical strength. For this reason, vaccination is widely recommended.

However, there are some people who should not be vaccinated.

- People with apparent fever (*1)
- People suffering from severe acute illness
- People who have a history of severe allergic reaction (*2) to any of the ingredient of this vaccine.
- People with conditions other than those listed above who are inappropriate for receiving vaccinations.

(*1) Obvious fever is usually defined as 37.5°C or higher. However, if the temperature is below 37.5°C, it is still considered a fever in light of the normal body temperature.

(*2) Anaphylaxis or multiple symptoms that raise suspicion of anaphylaxis, such as generalized skin and mucous membrane symptoms, wheezing, dyspnea, tachycardia, and hypotension.

There are some people who are recommended to be vaccinated, but who need [Attention]

- Patients undergoing anticoagulation therapy
- Patients with thrombocytopenia or coagulation disorders
- People who have been diagnosed with immunodeficiency in the past
- People who have a close relative with congenital immunodeficiency.
- People with underlying diseases such as heart, kidney, liver, blood disorders, or developmental disorders.
- People who have received vaccinations in the past and have experienced symptoms suspected of allergy such as fever or generalized rash within 2 days after vaccination.
- People who have had a history of convulsions in the past.
- People who may be allergic to any of the ingredient of this vaccine.

Please check the contents before making an inquiry. Also, if possible, please ask the doctor directly when you visit the hospital.
